The Story of Walt James

Walt became an early member of the Castaic Lions Club that was chartered in 1954. Walt was always giving back to the community and his membership in the Castaic Lions Club was his way of doing that. He had served the Club in many capacities, including the presidency. He was extremely proud of the many programs Castaic Lions Club supported. One of the programs which was most important to Walt was the Scholarship program for deserving local students graduating from High School and heading off to college.

Walt was a decorated World War II veteran, flying 26 missions as Lead Bombardier/Navigator, based in England. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal of Honor.

Walt was the founder, architect, builder and General Manager of the newly formed Indian Dunes Motorcycle Park in 1969. He transformed 600 + acres adjacent to Castaic, along the Santa Clara River into a premier motorcycle and dune buggy racing facility which opened June of 1970 and remained in operation until 1985.

Walt loved racing and he was President of the Western Racing Assn (WRA), racing older Sprint Cars and Midgets. Walt built a track for WRA in 1992, and it was named WALT JAMES STADIUM in his honor. Every year since, on Thanksgiving weekend, Walt and his wife Dottie hosted the WALT JAMES VINTAGE GATHERING and this tradition continued until his passing away on September 9, 2009, at the age of 86.
